

FAQ for Evolve[®]

Q What are the active ingredients in Evolve[®]?

A: Each gram of Evolve[®] worm paste contains: 140mg of Praziquantel and 18.7mg of Ivermectin.

Q: What are the available sizes?

A: Evolve[®] is available in a single unit package. Soon to be available in buckets of 50.

Q: What is the dose rate of Evolve[®]?

A: The recommended dose rate of Evolve[®] is 1 mL/100kg bodyweight. The contents of one Evolve[®] syringe (6mL) will treat one horse of 600kg bodyweight.

Q. How many applications do I get from a tube?

A. It depends on the weight of your horse. The recommended dose rate of Evolve[®] is 1mL/100kg bodyweight. The contents of one Evolve[®] syringe (6mL) will treat one horse of 600kg bodyweight. Each weight mark on the syringe plunger represents one dose for 100kg of bodyweight.

Q. What worms does Evolve[®] treat?

A. Evolve[®] is a broad spectrum wormer and Boticide for horses which treats and controls roundworms (including arterial larval stages of *Strongylus vulgaris* and benzimidazole resistant small strongyles), tapeworms, bots and skin lesions caused by Habronema and Draschia sp. (summer sores) and Onchocerca sp. microfilariae (cutaneous onchocerciasis) in horses.

Q. Is Evolve[®] safe to use in pregnant mares, stallions, older horses and foals?

A. Yes. Evolve[®] displays a wide safety margin at the recommended dose rate of 1mL/100kg bodyweight. It may be used in both young foals to very old animals. Mares may be treated at any stage of pregnancy and fertility will not be affected in either sex.

Q. How should I administer Evolve[®] to my horse?

A. Screw the plastic adjuster out to the weight of the horse, insert the syringe into the side of the horse's mouth between the front and back teeth and deposit the paste towards the back of the tongue by depressing the plunger quickly as far as it will go. Immediately raise the horse's head for a few seconds to ensure the full dose has been accepted.

Q. How often do I need to worm?

A. All horses should be regularly wormed to maintain good health and peak condition. Particular attention should be given to young horses and mares. Foals should be treated initially at 6 to 8 weeks of age and this treatment repeated regularly as required. Consult a veterinarian when developing a worm control program to suit your needs.



Q What is the meat withholding period for Evolve®?

A Evolve® should not be used less than 28 days before slaughter for human consumption.

Q I currently use/sell a wormer which does the job I need?

A Evolve® is an oral broad spectrum paste presented in low volume formulation which is used for the treatment and control of roundworms, tapeworms, bots and nematode skin lesions in horses. In addition, Evolve® has an easy grip for administering; pleasant flavour to aid palatability; and is Australian owned, developed and manufactured.

Q What is the shelf life of Evolve®?

A Evolve® is stable for two years from the date of manufacture when stored according to the label directions.

Q What are the storage instructions for Evolve® syringe?

A Evolve® should be stored below 30°C (room temperature) well protected from sunlight.

Q How should the empty packaging be disposed?

A The empty container and syringe should be disposed off by wrapping with paper and putting in garbage.
